

Health and Safety Policy

Review problems and hazards both observed by and reported to members of Senior Management and ensure risk assessments are conducted and acted upon in all relevant matters.

The Company is aware of its responsibilities under COSHH regulations and will ensure registers and data files of appropriate materials are maintained at each of its sites and necessary precautions identified are taken.

The Company will, through its training policy, ensure that all employees are instructed in health and safety procedures and fire precautions and that Supervisors and Managers with health and safety responsibilities are adequately trained to meet these responsibilities. Also that adequate training is given in the use of all equipment used on the premises with specific reference to health and safety, the provision of First Aid, and the importance of machine guarding.

The Company will ensure through its hazard reporting scheme and quality control or other communication channels that a constant watch is kept on health and safety matters as they affect day-to-day operations in the workplace.

Safety is everyone's business and relies on the vigilance and conscientiousness of all employees.
